### 1.2. Protection of the environment

Spotter B.V. has opted to dispense with all superfluous packaging and has ensured that the packaging materials are easy to separate.

## 2. Preparation

### 2.1. Connection

1. Fasten the microUSB cable to the EU plug that is supplied with the Spotter GPS Tracker. You do this by plugging the USB connector of the USB cable into the USB port of the EU plug.
2. Plug the EU plug into the power socket.
3. Attach the Spotter Dock to the microUSB cable. You do this by plugging the microUSB connection of the cable into the microUSB socket at the rear of the Spotter Dock.
4. Place the Spotter GPS Tracker upright in the Spotter Dock with the logo facing the front.
5. The Spotter charges when the red light on the front of the Spotter Dock starts glowing.

## 3. Technical data

Input voltage: 100-240V / 50-60Hz

Dimensions (w x h x d): 76 x 76 x 34 mm.

## 4. Maintenance

You should use a soft cloth to clean the Spotter Dock. Dampen the cloth slightly with a gentle cleaning fluid, which must **not** contain alcohol, methylated spirit, ammonia or caustic substances.

## 5. Repairing faults

The warranty is **not** applicable if you try to repair the Spotter Dock yourself. Never open the device. If a problem arises, contact our customer service at [support@spottergps.com](mailto:support@spottergps.com).

## 6. Warranty

The warranty period on the hardware is 24 months and takes effect at the time the Spotter Dock is delivered. You can find more information about the terms of the warranty in our General Conditions, Articles 15 and 16.

The Spotter Dock is **not** watertight. Make sure that it does not come into contact with water.
